The conference will be held from Dec. 14-17, 2014 at C-DOT, New Delhi.

The distinguishing characteristic of IEEE ANTS is the promotion of an intense dialogue between academia and industry to bridge the gap between academic research, industry initiatives and governmental policies. This is fostered through panel discussions, keynotes, invited talks and exhibits/demos where academia is exposed to state-of-practice and results from trials, and interoperability experiments.
